MOUTHGUARD CARE GUIDE

To help extend the life of your new mouthguard, here are a few tips on proper mouthguard care.

After each use, rinse under cold tap water to remove any saliva. When dry, ensure the mouthguard is stored in the container provided in a cool dry place. If your mouthguard requires a more thorough clean you can wash it in warm (not hot) soapy water.

Once a month or so we recomme nd that you soak your mouthguard in 'Milton' antibacterial solution. This is also used to sterilize baby bottles and can be purchased from a chemist or supermarket. Dilute this at a ratio of 50:50 with water and soak the mouthguard in it for 3 minutes, then rinse thoroughly with tap water. Take care as this product will corrode any metal surfaces.

The following will reduce the durability or destroy the mouthguard, so should be avoided:

- * Chewing on the mouthguard, especially when it is not fitted properly over the teeth
- * Cleaning the mouthguard with toothpaste or other abrasive substances
- * Placing into hot or boiling water
- * Putting them through the washing machine or dryer
- * Not storing them correctly in their storage container in a safe place yes, a few have actually been chewed up by the family dog!
- * Trying to re-mould the mouthguard if it is rubbing, ill fitting or becomes disfigured
